It is on a quiet street just one block from all the restaurants on Rue Abesses and two blocks from the Abesses metro station, so very convenient. Everything that we needed was in the apartment. The manager, Karla was so patient answering our emails, about 20 all totaled and was very helpful when my husband became ill. Paris actually has doctors that make house calls, amazing! We tried about 10 of the restaurants in Montmartre area and we were happy with all of them so it would be difficult to pick just one. Since we stayed a month, we became familiar with both the metro system and the buses which were so easy to use to get to all the tourist areas.
